By Rail: Metro North to New Rochelle... and look for the
 ArtsFest signs!
 From Upper Westchester and Connecticut: Take 684 S.
 to 287 E. to Exit 16. Follow signs to North Ave.
 Left turn onto North Ave. and look for the Arts Fest signs!
 Take Hutchinson River Parkway S to Exit 18E — New
 Rochelle /Mill Rd. Bear right onto Mill Road and right at
 light onto North Ave. Take North Ave. and watch for the
 ArtsFest signs!
 From Lower Westchester and Manhattan: Hutchinson
 River Parkway S to exit 9, toward Whitestone Bridge.
 Merge onto Hutchinson Parkway S. Take exit 12 — East
 Lincoln Ave/Pelham/Mount Vernon. Turn right, and right
 again onto Lincoln Ave. Follow Lincoln to North Ave. Turn
 right onto North Ave. and look for the ArtsFest signs!
 or
 I-95 N to Exit 15 New Rochelle/the Pelhams. Turn right at
 the end of the ramp and look for ArtsFest signs!
